EU categories

Pedelec

• ≤ 25 kph

• \leq 250 Watt

Pedal Assisted

Falls within bicycle CEN standards



Speed Pedelec

• ≤ 45 kph

• \leq 4,000Watt (usually 500 - 750 W)

Pedal Assisted

Falls within EU motor vehicle
Type Approval



How do national authorities define them? Pedelec



Speed Pedelec

- ≤ 25 kph
- ≤ 250 V/att
- Pedal Assisted

Falls within bicycle CEN standards

- \leq 45 kph
- \leq 4,000Watt (usually 500 750 W)
- Pedal Assisted

Falls within EU motor vehicle regs

Road Rules for S-Pedelecs



| | Helmet | License | age | Infrastructure | Insurance |
|----|--------------------------|-------------------------|-----|---|------------------------|
| BE | Bicycle Helmet | Moped License and plate | 16 | Signed routes in urban areas, Bicycles highways speed < 30 | Insurance mandatory |
| NL | S-pedelec helmet | Moped License and plate | 16 | Yes on bicycle infrastructure but speed limits apply | Insurance mandatory |
| DE | Helmet type? | Moped License and Plate | 16 | Most urban bicycle paths prohibited | Insurance mandatory |
| UK | Full motorbike helmet | Moped License and plate | 16 | Road only | Insurance mandatory |

Mandatory Motor vehicle Insurance Directive

CHAPTER 1

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1

Definitions

For the purposes of this Directive:

 'vehicle' means any motor vehicle intended for travel on land and propelled by mechanical power, but not running on rails, and any trailer, whether or not coupled;

Mountain bike exemption in Type Approval

Article 2

Scope

(g) vehicles primarily intended for off-road use and designed to travel on unpaved surfaces;
